SECTION 25. SOLID WASTE FEES That there is hereby imposed a Household Solid Waste Fee in Greene County. The Solid Waste Fee is composed of an availability fee of \$41.00 per residential unit, which is applied uniformly throughout the County, including incorporated municipalities. The Solid Waste Fee is also composed of a user fee in the amount of \$41.00 per residential unit per year, which is applied only to the unincorporated areas of Greene County and to those incorporated municipalities in Greene County that do not provide a system of municipal solid waste collection. Solid Waste Fees were originally set

forth and more particularly described in an ordinance approved by the Board of County Commissioners dated July 6, 1993. The tipping fee at the Greene County Landfill will be \$46.00 per ton effective July 1, 2015.
