

# REQUEST FOR GENERAL CONTRACTOR PRE-QUALIFICATION PROPOSALS

## Greene County Wellness & Recreational Facility

Greene County is seeking qualification statements for General Contractors for the construction of a Wellness & Recreational Facility located in Snow Hill, North Carolina.

The project consists of site grading and construction of 27,229 square feet to include the following: basketball court (gymnasium), 6 retractable goals, scoreboard, pullout bleachers, Men's & Women's locker rooms, elevated stage, dressing rooms, 3 multi-purpose rooms (exercise, dance, art, etc.) exercise equipment room, office area, storage areas, concession area, platform type booth for stage lighting area, and a ticket booth, all located on one main level. Appropriate storage and mechanical spaces will be provided. Exact room sizes and room placements will be dependent upon site conditions and programmatic requirements. The site will consist of paved, lighted and landscaped parking area for 61 vehicles with access road and appropriate signage.

To qualify, the contractor must have a general contractor's license in the State of North Carolina as well as applicable bonding requirements. The contractor must have completed, within the last (8) eight years, three projects similar in scope with a value exceeding Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00)

Applicants must submit a sealed, fully completed Contractor Qualification Statement/Application Package by 5 PM Monday, March 19, 2018, to the Greene County Manager's office at the address noted above. Application packages are available immediately. Greene County has an affirmative policy to foster, promote and conduct business with women and minority owned enterprises. Women and minority owned contractors are encouraged to participate in the prequalification process.
